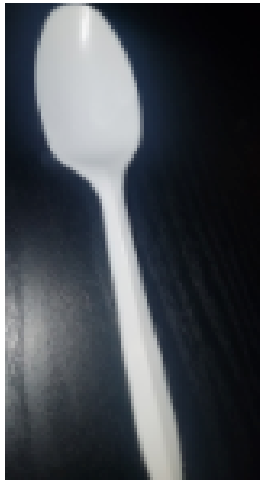




# How to Make a Forky

FROM TOY STORY 4

## Supplies:



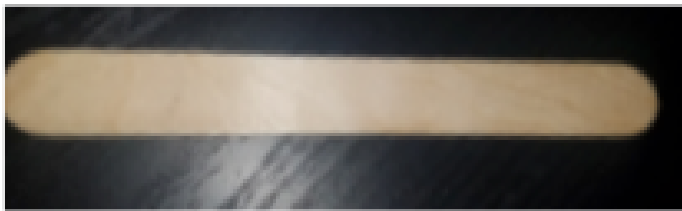
**A plastic spoon.** Flimsy, like the cheap ones from school.



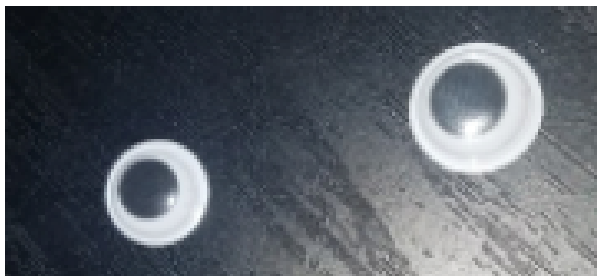
**One red pipe cleaner.**



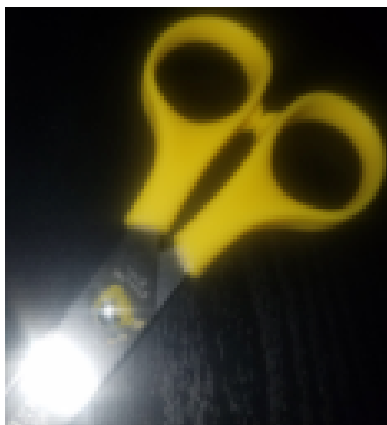
**Two rubber bands.** One red, one blue.



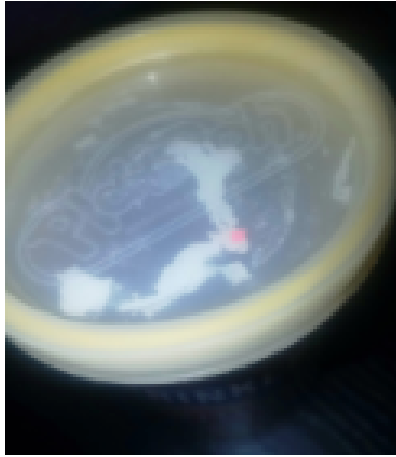
**A popsicle stick.**



**Two googly eyes.** Different sizes.



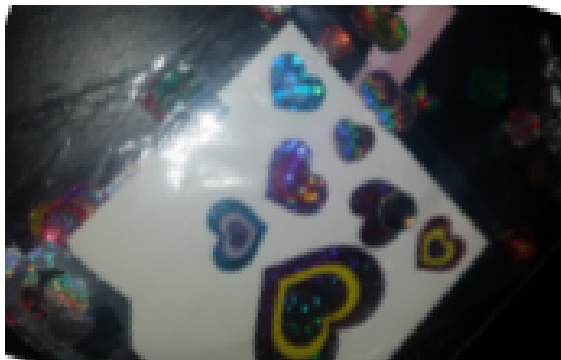
**Scissors.**



**Playdough.** White, cream or gray. Or any type of clay.



**Glue.** Super glue works the best, but hot glue will work too.

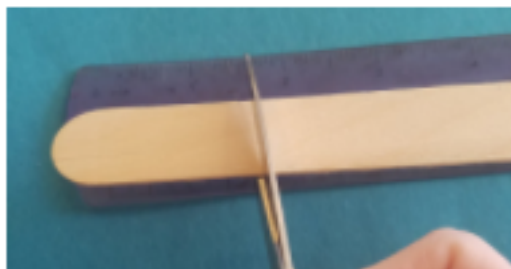


**Stickers of any kind.** (Optional.)

**Start** by carefully cutting 3 triangles out of the top of the spoon. This will change your spoon into a spork. If needed, get an adult to help you with this step.



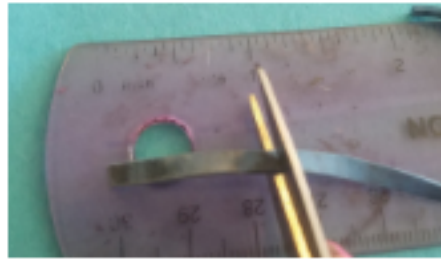
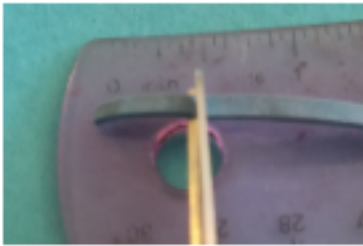
**Next** cut one half-inch off each end of the popsicle stick. You should end up with 3 different pieces. You might need an adult with bigger scissors to do this. You will only use the two pieces with the round sides.



**Trim** the red rubber band to one inch. Depending on the width of the rubber band you may also have to cut it in half.



The blue rubber band needs to be in two separate pieces. One, a half-inch long, the other, one-inch long. You may also want to cut this rubber band in half as well.



Set what you cut aside for later.

*Now* take the pipe cleaner and bend it in half.



Place the spork in the middle of the pipe cleaner bend



Wrap the pipe cleaner around the spork so it will stay.



Set aside for a minute.

**Roll** the dough/clay into a ball around one inch in diameter.



Push the bottom of the spork into the ball you just made.

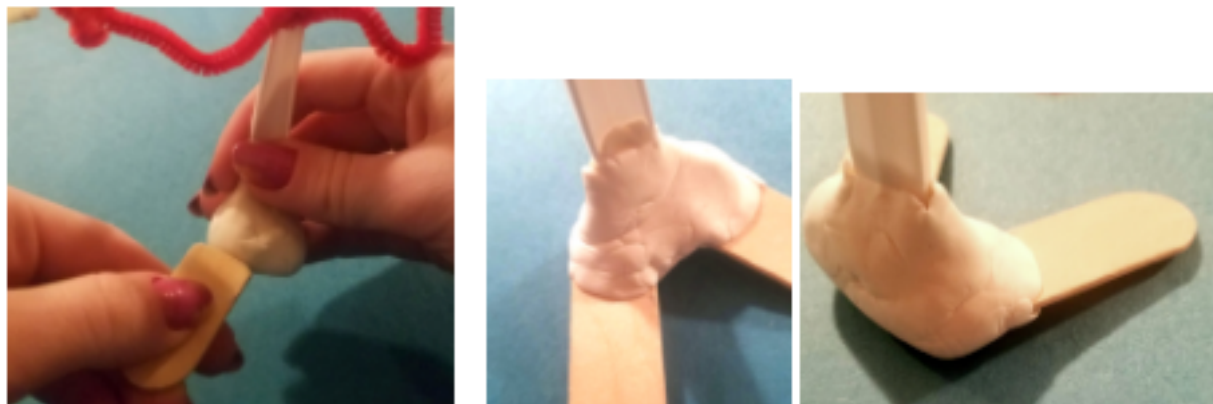


Mold the clay around the spork into an almost cone shape.





Push one of the popsicle sticks you cut into one side of the front of the clay. Followed by the next one on the other side. Mold clay around the popsicle sticks as shown.



**Get** an adult to help you with these final steps.

**Glue** the eyes onto the backside of the spork with the smaller eye on your right.



Take the red rubber band you cut at the beginning. This is the eyebrow. Place it right above the eyes, in a curved position, and carefully glue it down. The middle of the eyebrow should be closest to the prongs.



**Last** for the mouth. Start with the smaller blue rubber band you cut. Place it around a millimeter under the eyes. Glue down.



Then place one side of the longer blue rubber band one each side of the blue rubber band you have glued down as shown.



Stick a sticker of your choice on the left foot (popsicle stick)



Let dry overnight and your Forky is finished!



# HOW TO: GROW STRAWBERRIES

## MATERIALS:

- Strawberries (Grown in the U.S.)
- Paper Towel
- Plastic Zip-up bag
- Pot
- Soil
- Toothpick

## STEP 1:

Take your toothpick and pick about 30 seeds off of the strawberry. Place them on a paper towel. Get it slightly damp. Spraying them with a spray bottle is recommended. Make sure they aren't too wet. Place them inside a zip-up plastic bag and seal it tightly. Place them in the fridge for about 2 weeks. After 2 weeks, place them in a warm- preferably dark- spot until you begin to see sprouts.

## Step 2:

Once you have begun to see sprouts, it is time to move your strawberry plants to some soil! Take a small pot or container and fill it almost all of the way to the top with soil. Take your finger and dig out a small divot in the soil. Carefully place one of your seedlings inside the divot. Fill in around the seedling with soil. Lightly press it so that the seedling is secure. Dampen the soil lightly with water. Be careful not to drown the seedling. Repeat for the other sprouts that you have. Place them in a spot that gets good sunlight during the day. Don't move them outside unless it is warm. Water them every other day- making sure not to drown them.

## Step 3:

If you want to move them to an outside garden, do so in June. They will take a while to grow 😊.

## Step 4:

While you are waiting, use your extra strawberries to make this strawberry slush, or some other recipe!

**2 cups (500ml) strawberries**    **1 cup (250ml) water**  
**½ cup (150ml) sugar**

**Preparation time:** Steps 1-3: 20 minutes + overnight freezing time  
Step 4: 5 minutes

**1** Making simple syrup is easy! Slowly cook the sugar with the water in a saucepot until the sugar is dissolved. Boil it some more until you have only ½ cup (150ml) (10-12 minutes) — and let it cool to room temperature before using.

**2** Add the berries to a food processor fitted with a steel knife and pulse until the berries are chopped finely but not mushy!

**3** Mix the berries and syrup in a glass bowl, then scrape into a plastic container with a lid.

Freeze overnight.

**4** Set the bottom of the plastic container in hot water for a few seconds to loosen the slush. While still in the container, cut with a dull knife into small chunks and plop into the processor. Whizz for a minute or less, until it's a creamy frozen yummy glob. Scrape down the sides and whizz for another 5 seconds.

**To Serve** Spoon into chilled glasses and serve with a berry on top.

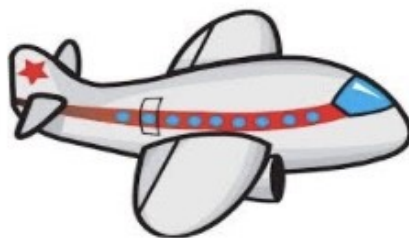

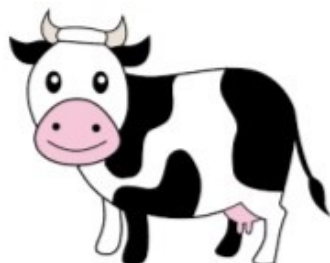
