### How to adopt a tree:

#### 1. Contact Ogden Botanical Gardens Staff:

- 2. **Make an appointment:** Set up a time to walk through the Ogden Botanical Gardens to select a tree to adopt and complete an Adopt-A-Tree agreement form.
- 3. Pay the participant fee: \$500.00 (This is separate from the cost of the plaque).
- 4. **Arrange for and purchase a plaque:** Plaques for the Ogden Botanical Gardens Adopt-A-Tree are prepared at *Nova Color Inc.* in Ogden. They can be reached at (801) 621-7840 and are located at 2641 Industrial Drive, Ogden, UT, 84401. The plaques will fit the required specifications (see below) and be paid for by the participant.
