INDOOR ARENA SCHEDULE

Riding is from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. at the Cache County Indoor Arena.

All participants using the indoor riding facilities must be registered in 4-H. All participants must wear boots with a heel, no tennis shoes. Safety at all times. Please check your equipment regularly to make sure it is in safe working condition.

If you have a horse that kicks: Please place a red ribbon in their tail on ride nights.

 - Dec 12.....Western/slow/judged events
 - Dec 19.....Fast/speed events
 - Dec. 26..Must be registered with 4-H office... Working Ranch

All 4-H riders must clean up after themselves and their horses before they leave the arena.
