- A committee was formed to implement drug testing of horses used in the horse shows.



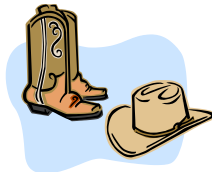
Healthy Horse Clinic Saturday April 17th

Western Riding Clinic

On May 8th and 9th at the Hyrum arena, Hal and April Schiffner of Rising Sun Quarter Horses from Castledale Utah will present a clinic on Western Riding.

Hal is from Canada, and trained horses in California. He and April recently moved their training facility to Utah to be more centralized. Hal trains for all disciplines, and has taken several youth to the Worlds.

Hal will be concentrating on training your horse for this discipline, and show techniques that will help the youth with this class.

Enrollment is limited to 30 kids, 1st come 1st served. One year of 4-H show experience required. The age of the rider and horse are not important. If the rider and horse are able to obtain the correct lead, and execute a lead change, than they will be placed in the advanced. If you are struggling with leads and changes, than enroll in the beginners. Each division will be taught useful training tips that will advance you and your horse.

Cost is \$25 for 1st youth and \$45 for 2 or more youth in a family. Attendance is optional on Sunday. Enrollment will be opened to other counties in 2 weeks if slots are still available.
