- 4-H Horsemanship Helmet Rule
- Effective January 2011, helmets will be required for ALL western under saddle and bareback events occurring at 4-H sponsored horse shows.
- Riders without helmets will not be allowed to enter the event arena and will be disqualified from their class.
- As previously stated in the Utah 4-H horse rulebook, Utah 4-H highly encourages the use of helmets during ALL equestrian events. When purchasing an equestrian helmet, riders

should look for American Society for Testing Materials (ASTM) and Safety Equipment Institute (SEI) certification. These certifications insure that the helmet complies with the basic helmet safety regulations. Helmets not certified by ASTM and SEI do not comply with industry standard and may offer sub-standard protection.
