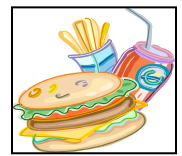


Everyone must get in and get registered for 4-H (tell your friends) so you can get all the information that we will be sending out. You must be registered to ride at the clinics or ride nights.

America's Healthy Horse comes to Cache Valley. This is a great way to cover all your horses spring health needs at a **discounted price of \$50.00 per horse.**

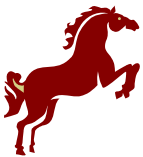
The horses will get:

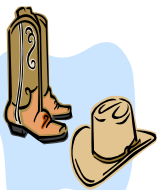
