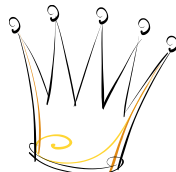


Cache County Horse 4-H Benefit Rodeo Information Saturday, June 19, 2010

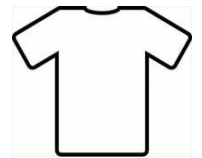
