All participants using the indoor riding facilities must be registered in 4-H. All participants must wear boots with a heel, no tennis shoes. Safety at all times. Please check your equipment regularly to make sure it is in safe working condition.

Horses that kick: Place a red ribbon in their tail on ride nights.
