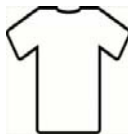

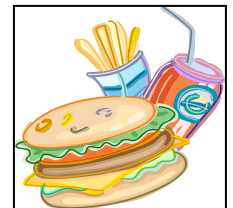

Times are as follows:

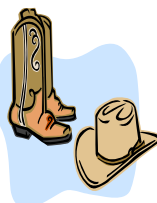
9:00 a.m.-10:30 a.m. - 10:30 a.m.-12:00 noon
