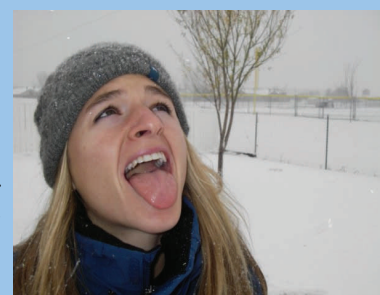


### Save the Dates!
