Vendor Information

- Booth space 10' x 10'
- Booths to be open: Friday 7th from 2-8pm, Saturday 8th from 9am-5pm
- Event will take place rain or shine.
- Vendors will provide their own tables, tents and displays (most vendor will be indoors).
- Vendors are responsible for clean up of their assigned area (a clean up fee will be charged if site are not left clean)
- True Western arts and handcrafts only (also this is a family friendly event, family content only)
- Like vendors will be limited. We reserve the right to reject any vendor. Vendor booths limited to first 25 applicants.
- Each vendor must apply for a Panguitch City vendor permit, accompanied with \$25.00 or hold a valid Panguitch City Business license
- Booth spaces will be assigned, vendor will not receive site assignment until Friday Oct. 7 at noon
- Vendors are responsible for the security of their own booths and belongings during the event.
- Vendors are responsible for collecting and remitting tax during the event. Panguitch sales tax is 8% on goods and 9% on food
- Trade Show will take place at the Triple C arena in Panguitch



Fees and Registration Information

- Each vendor must provide two door prizes valued at \$10 (ten) or more. Door prizes will be used for a vendor fair drawing and 4-H Gathering Awards.
- Fee of \$25 (twenty-five) for Panguitch City vendor permit which must be mailed with application. Does not apply to applicant who hold a valid Panguitch City business license.
- Vendor Application must be postmarked by September 15, 2011, must be filled out in full with a detailed description of all items that will be available for sale in your booth (enclose a picture is possible). Provide a menu if Food Vendor
- Vendors will be notified (by e-mail, mail or phone) of booth confirmation and receipt after applications are received and reviewed, if you do not receive confirmation, please call.
- Application does not guarantee a booth spot
- If space permits late applications maybe available at an additional charge of \$25
- All fees (above the required vendor permit) collected during this Festival are a donation the Garfield County 4-H Working Ranch Horse Youth Program.
