Cowboy "Bean Chili" Cook Off Rules and Guidelines

- \$15.00 entry fee. Registration must be post-marked by September 21, 2010.
- Shotgun start @ 9:00 a.m. October 9th.
- Must make a minimum of 2 gallons of chili per entry.
- Chili must be prepared at the rodeo grounds over an open fire (examples: Camp Chief, BBQ, or portable bottomed fire pit). No electricity available. Assigned cooking station will be outdoors, please be as sanitary as possible.
- Serving to the public (Judging) will start at 12:00 noon. Sampling cup and spoon will be provided to the Public at the cost of \$2.00.
- Contestants must supply any and all equipment/product necessary for competition.
- Chili must have a minimum of one bean type. Entry may have more than one bean type, meat or other filler.
- Unlimited entry. Make as many different entries as you desire.
- One category and one age division. All entries regardless of Chili make up, team size or individuals age will compete against one another.
- Public "Peoples Choice" will determine contest winners. All entries will be given a number and bucket with corresponding number for Public to vote for favorite Chili.
- Cash Prizes*. First place will win \$150.00 plus a trophy and, second place \$75.00 plus trophy, and third place \$50.00 plus certificate. *Cash Prizes may vary depending on number of entries.



Cowboy Poetry Jubilee Rules and Guidelines

- \$5.00 entry fee. Registration must be post-marked by September 21, 2010.
- Event approximately 2 p.m. October 9th, following 4-H Working Ranch Horse Gathering. Start time may vary.
- No theme but family content only.
- Poem or lyrics must be submitted with registration (typed in readable font style and size). Submissions will not be published or otherwise duplicated. They are used solely for review of content.
- Five minute time limit per entry. Entries over five minutes will be disqualified!
- Age divisions: Pee-Wee 3-8 years old (participation award only, no placing)
Junior 9-11 years, Intermediate 12-15 years, Senior 16-18 years, Adult 19 or older- Humorous and Serious Categories for adult division
- Entries may be original or someone else's poem/lyrics.
- Limited to the first 25 entries. One entry type per contestant (adults may enter in both humorous and serious categories).
- Judging will be based on a point system. The individual with the most points awarded by each judge will determine the winner of each age group.
- Points will be based on memorization, appearance, presentation, style, and flow of material.
- Cash prizes for 1st- \$100.00, 2nd -\$50.00 and 3rd- \$25.00 in each age division and each adult category with exception to the Pee-wee division. Pee-wee division will receive participation awards. *Cash Prizes may vary depending on number of entries.
