## Landscape Use

Beautiful and desirable, but highly variable depending on cultivar. Medium growth rate and can get very tall and wide. Placing two or three together in a large-scale landscape can be very impressive. Long, weeping branchlets on some cultivars are very attractive. Like blue spruce, many planted trees are being killed by spruce ips beetle attack, made worse

by chronic under-watering. Zones 2-7.
