4-H Offers Teen Leadership Training

Utah State University Extension 4-H offers Teen Leadership Training on the USU campus in Logan Oct. 1 - 3 for students in grades 9 through 12 interested in developing leadership skills and in teaching and mentoring younger youths. Those attending the training can choose from among the main topics of robotics, science, or nutrition and fitness.

A team is made up of two to four teens and an adult coach. If those who sign up come as a team with an adult coach and commit to teach the curriculum to at least 15 youths, team members will each receive a \$100 scholarship toward the registration fee. Youths who come without a team are welcome to participate at the full cost of registration, which ranges from \$145 to \$190 for youths and \$165 to \$215 for adults, depending on room occupancy.
