5 Tips for Post Calving Nutrition

- 1. Take stock of all feed resources available before winter feeding and plan on how to use resources according the nutritional requirements of animals.
- Take forage samples of feed. This will allow you to know if you need to supplement or decrease a certain feed.
- 3. Use tools such as nutrient requirement charts or ration balancing software to determine nutrient requirements of your cattle.
- 4. Watch cattle for change in body condition score (BCS). Cattle with lower BCS will have decreased conception rates.
- 5. Talk to your local county agent or specialist if you have questions.
