Private pesticide applicators with a current license can earn the six hours of continuing education units (CEUs) required to renew their license. Individuals without a license who complete the class will satisfy the requirements to become a certified private pesticide applicator in Utah. **Please bring a calculator to class.**

Private Pesticide Applicator: *Any person who purchases, uses, or supervises the use of Restricted Use Pesticide(s) to produce any agricultural commodity on property owned or rented by that person or her or his employer or, if applied without compensation other than trading of services between producers of agricultural commodities, on the property of another person. These individuals are required by Utah Law to be licensed by the Utah Department of Agriculture and Food.*

Restricted Use Pesticide (RUP): *Registration assigned by the EPA to pesticide products that have a potentially high degree of human and/or environmental hazard. Pesticides designated as General Use (not RUP) do not require a license to purchase or use, and are available for sale to the general public.*

Cost for a three-year private applicator license (new or renew) is \$20 (new applicators please bring check or cash). If you have a current license, you will receive a sheet with CEU credit that will allow you to renew your license by mail during December of the year it expires.
