ATV Safety Course –June 23rd Special Event Center

Utah law requires youth ages 8-16 complete the Utah State parks and Recreation Know Before You Go! OHV education course before riding on public lands, roads or trails. The course is \$10 per student, which includes a home study course manual and the cost for the certification course. Each class lasts about four-hours, with a written test that takes an hour and a half and two hours of hands-on riding on a course. The course teaches: safe riding, proper machine sizing, weight distribution, responsible and ethical riding, proper handling and shifting, riding within your ability. What the participants HAVE to bring to the course: parent or legal guardian, properly sized and registered off-highway vehicle, pencil, approved helmet, goggles or face shield, gloves, long sleeved shirt, long pants, boots, snacks and water.

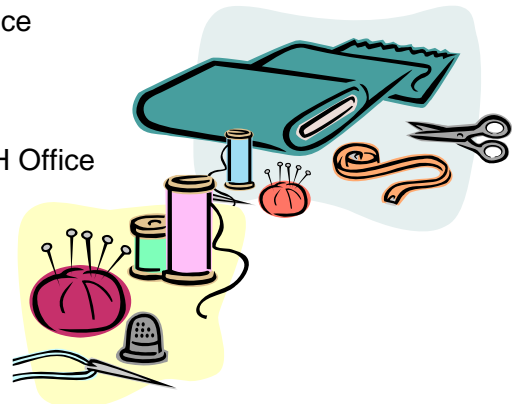

For youth ages 10 and above (limit 10 per class)

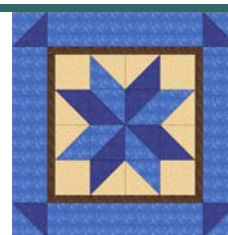
