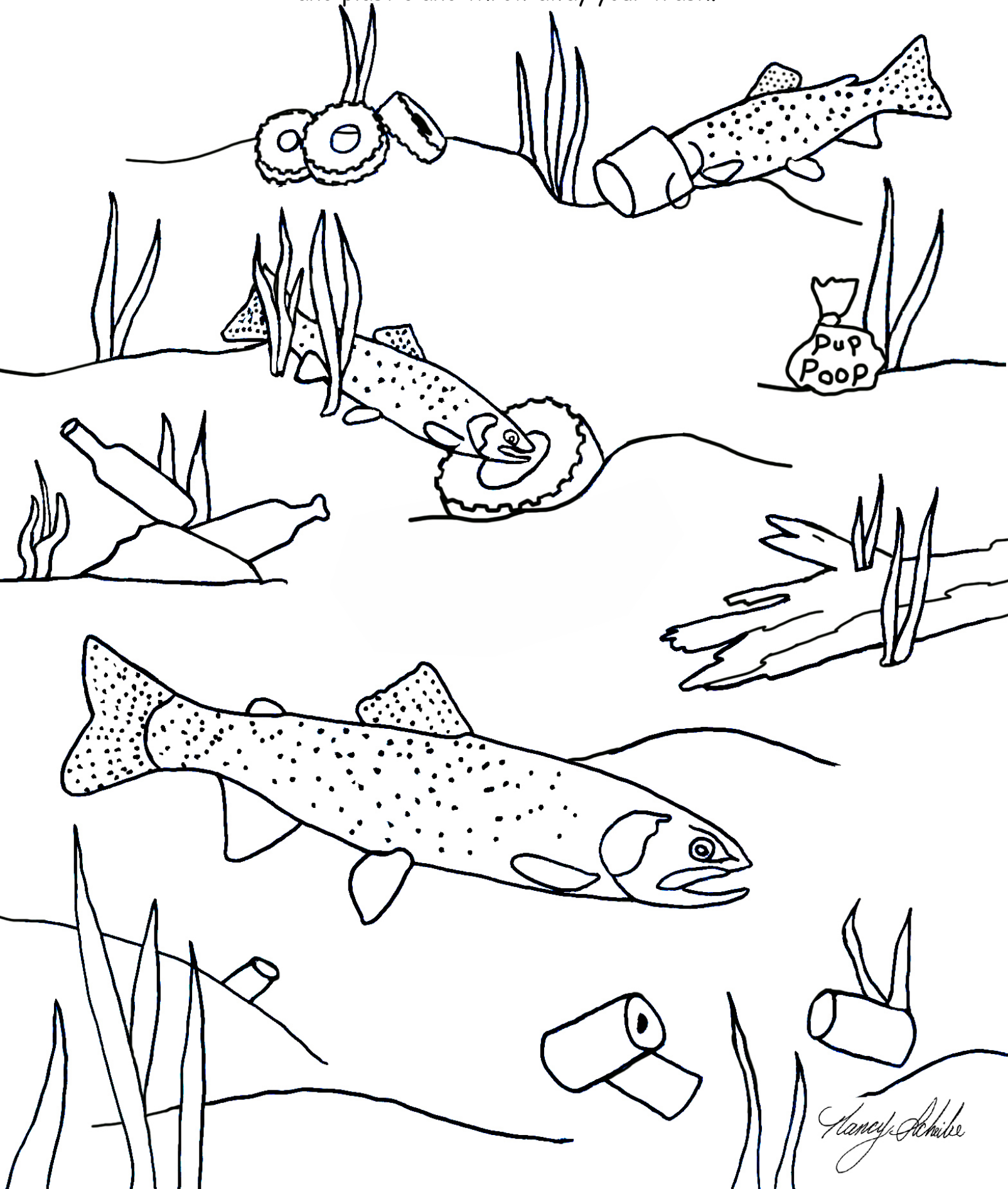


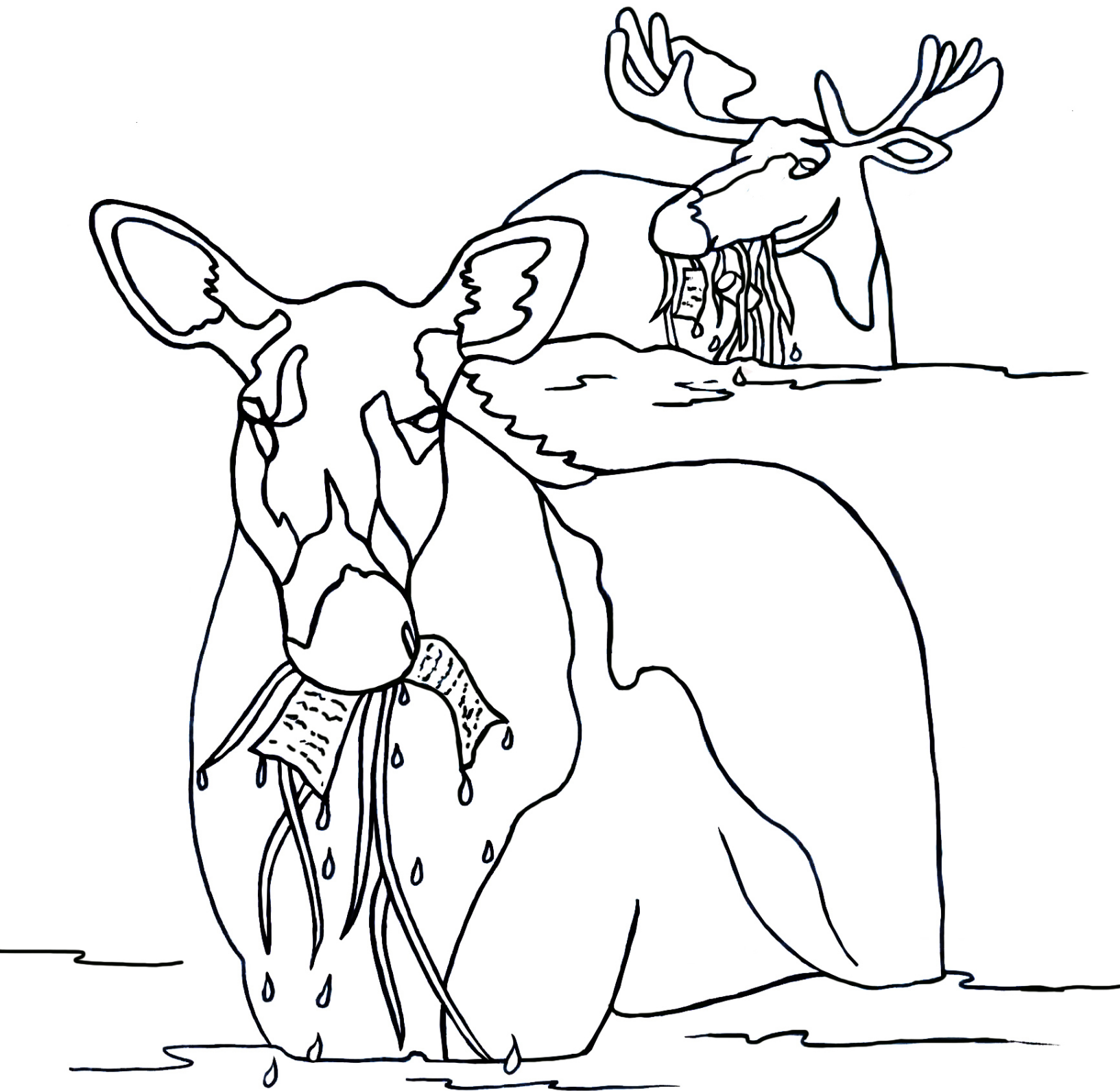
Nobody likes garbage and dog poop hanging on the walls. Clean up after your dogs and carry trash back to trail-head trashcans to keep the beaver's homes clean.

Do you like swimming with trash? Neither do we. Please recycle glass, cans and plastic and throw away your trash.





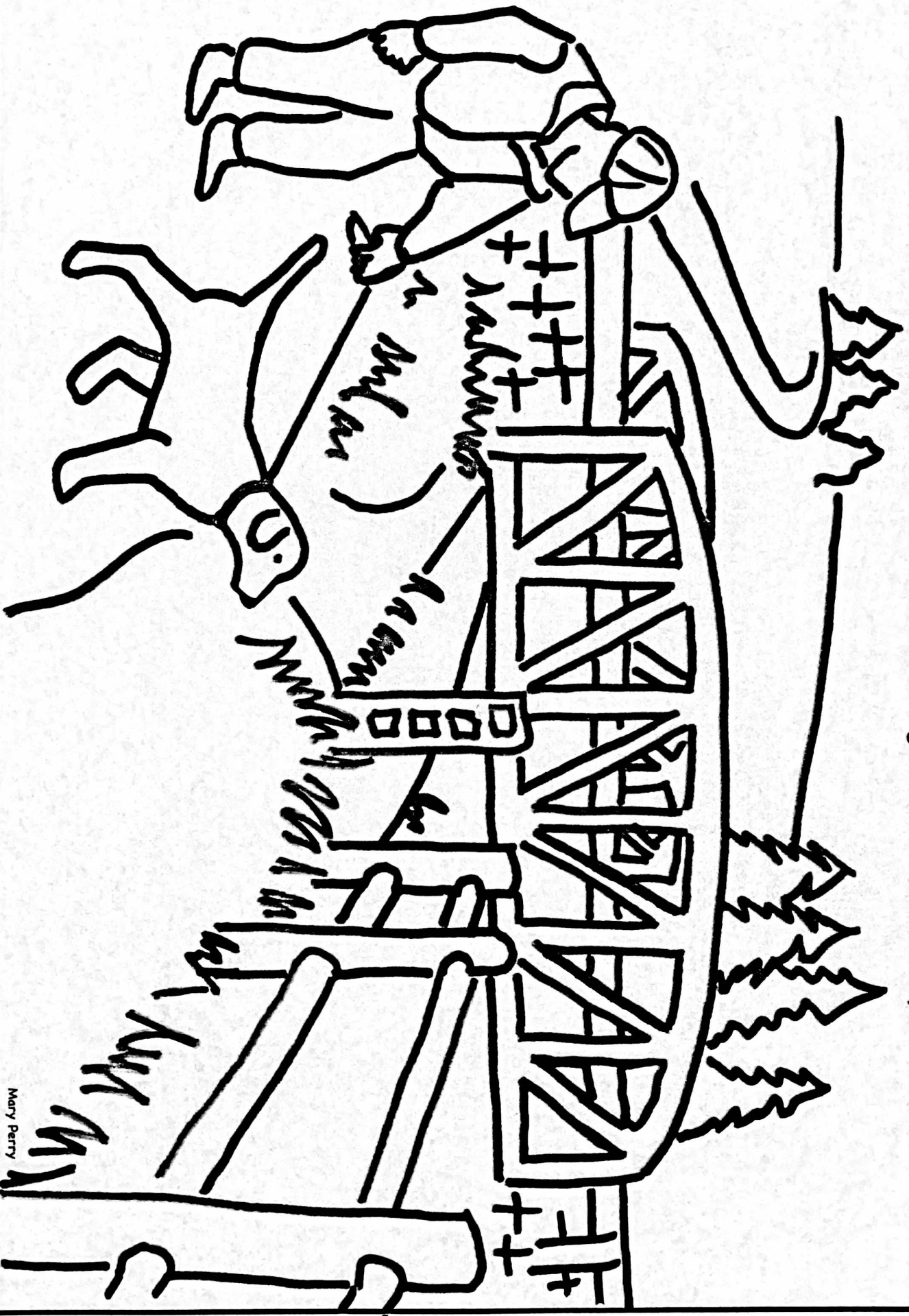
Moose don't like to munch on trash.

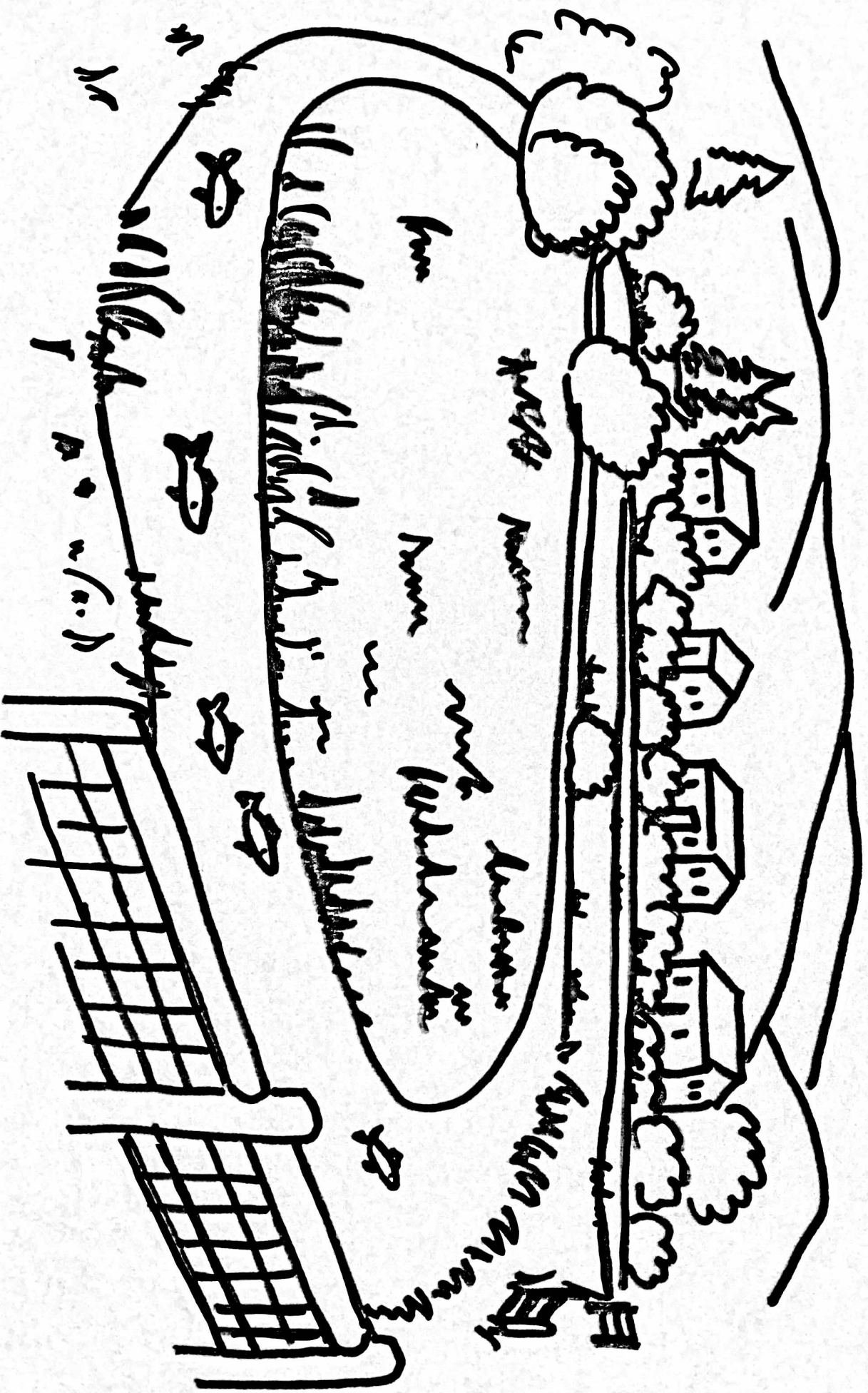
Oil that leaks from our cars onto roadways washes down into storm drains, and eventually makes it way to East Canyon Creek



Leashed pets are easier to clean up after, co-exist with wildlife on Swaner's land, and prevent conflict among various users. Leaving dog waste on trails contributes to excessive nutrients that cause algae blooms in East Canyon Creek.

"Limit fertilizer; be water wise; plant natives; keep plant buffers by the creek; use herbicides wisely"
