The Utah Stream Team is a volunteer monitoring program designed to provide an understanding of water quality through active involvement in local watersheds.



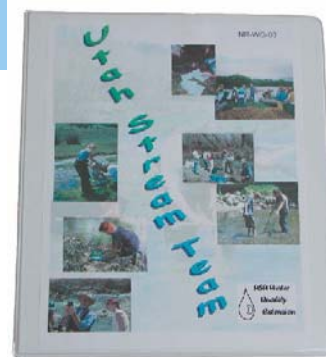
The program is flexible, easy to do, and offers a great learning experience for all participants.
