

Pull 40 Lbs of Dyer's Woad For a \$10 Bounty

WHO: Weber County youth, ages 6-18 years
WHAT: Pull 40 lbs. of Dyer's Woad and receive \$10/bag
WHERE: Within Weber County
WHEN: May 14-28, 2009
HOW:

- ▶ Pick up orange bags at the Weber County Fairgrounds Pavilion. (**Only official orange bags distributed here in 2009** will be accepted for the bounty.)
- ▶ Get them on Thursdays: May 14, or 21 (on a first-come basis). At covered picnic area on Weber County Fairgrounds 3-6:00 p.m.
 - ★ Limit of 2 bags per youth.

BAGGING 40 LBS. OF DYER'S WOAD:

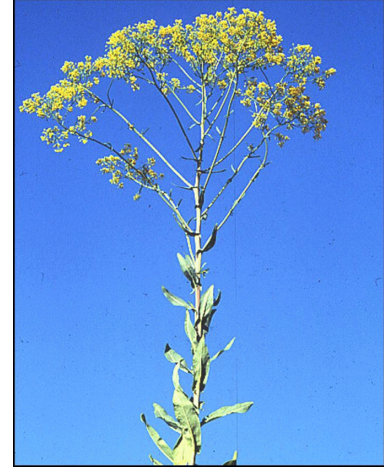
- ▶ Pull or dig plant **with 2"** of root; compact the whole plant in bag.
- ▶ Pull woad within Weber County and **note the location** to report when you deliver your bags.

COLLECTING THE BOUNTY:

- ▶ Bring your 40-lb bags of Dyer's Woad to the Weber County Fairgrounds picnic area (Riverdale Pavilion) to collect bounty
- ▶ May 21, 28 **only**
- ▶ 3:00 to 6:00 p.m. on the designated days.

★ **IF YOU WANT TO MAKE A DIFFERENCE:** Return to the same area each year, and clean out that particular section thoroughly!

Dyer's Woad is a noxious and invasive weed. It negatively impacts our natural ecosystems by displacing native vegetation and threatening the food supply of wildlife and livestock.
