

Frequently Asked Conference Questions:

Can I register at the door?

Based on the past few years it is anticipated that the event will be sold out. In the event there are still tickets available they will be on a first come first serve basis at the door for \$40 per couple or \$20 single (cash or check only). Please call 801-399-8207 in order to check if tickets are still available.

What does my registration include?

The cost of registration includes all workshops (including the bonus sessions) and light refreshments. You are welcome to attend any or all of the events during the evening.

What about dinner?

We encourage you to bring take-out and enjoy the excellent entertainment provided by Benjamin Jennings and The BBC 3 in the main atrium area of the Shepherd Union Building from 5:00pm-6:00pm. There will be a few eating establishments available on campus or there are several establishments located close to campus where you can purchase food.

Can I bring my kids?

This is a marriage education event for adults. As a courtesy to others, please do not bring infants or children.

Where should I park?

The A9, A10, or W8 parking lots are all available just slightly south west of the Student Union building, and are only a one to two minute walk to the building. There is plenty of parking and you will not be charged for this parking. Do not park in the pay parking lot unless the barricades are up and they do not require you to take a ticket or you will be required to pay.

What's the seating like this year?

Almost all of the main sessions have at least 150 seats available and will be on a first come first serve basis. Most of the main session workshops will be taught twice in order to accommodate everyone that would like to attend the sessions.

What's the dress and what do I need to bring?

The dress is semi-casual to casual. Please bring your own note taking supplies.
