Cache County Junior Livestock Scholarships—To be eligible for the scholarship, youth must have participated in the Junior Livestock program for at least two of the past three years, either through FFA or 4-H. Applicants should be in the 12th grade as of January 1, 2018. Youth not planning to attend college this fall, but plan to enroll in the future should apply now, and if awarded, the scholarship amount will be deferred until the student enrolls. This scholarship is valid for the student's Freshman year only.

Applications will be evaluated based on Junior Livestock program involvement, career goals with preference to agriculture-related business or industry, leadership experiences, involvement in extra curricular programs and financial need. Amount of the scholarship award is dependent on the number of qualified recipients. Scholarship is valid toward tuition, fees, and books at an accredited college or university.
