#### 4-H Enrollment or Reactivation guidelines

Every youth who desires to participate in Utah 4-H must enroll as a 4-H member.

- New member: Create a family and membership profile account at 4h.zsuite.org. Parents, please sign up to be a volunteer. Call our office if you need help 435-636-3233
- Reactivation: Each August 31st every 4-H membership is deactivated. This requires parents to review and update information regarding their youth. To reactivate your family profile log into 4h.zsuite.org.
- The annual fee for Utah 4-H enrollment is \$10.00.

Approval for enrollment takes one business day if you pay online with a credit or debit card.

#### Register for an event

- Once enrollment is approved, re-enter your 4h.zsuite.org account to register for a Summer Adventure Event. On the left side menu, select Event. You may scroll through the events to select an Event, or at the top of the event page, you may search for an Event.
- Approval for the Event takes one business day if you pay online with a credit or debit card.

If you choose to make enrollment and registration payments in the office, there is a 3 day grace period.
