HUNTER'S SAFETY


4-H'ers that want to participate in DC 4-H shooting sports must complete Hunter's Safety Training. We have arranged with DWR to host an in-person Field Day at the USU Kaysville Education Center. This Field Day is open to the public and will fill up fast.

This will be an approved online course followed by a required in-person field day: August 26, 6:30 pm for the written test; August 27, 3:30 pm at the Davis County Shooting Range for the live-fire shooting exercise.

- **Course details:**
 - The online course is self-paced (takes approximately 4-6 hours), and all sections must be completed before the field day.
 - The online course is provided by a private vendor which includes narration in both English or Spanish and has interactive animations.
 - **The required field day includes approximately 5 hours of attendance, completed over 1-2 days. During the in-person field day you must pass the final written test and a live-fire shooting exercise.**
- **Cost:** \$10* for a Hunter Education Registration Certificate + \$24.95 for the online course. There is also a \$5 cash room-fee for non-4-H participants to be collected upon arrival for the Field Day.
