- Three dates in September will be selected for the teaching opportunities.

### **Qualifications needed to apply for 4-H Air Force Teens as Teachers Leader Positions**

In order to be considered for the position as Teen Teacher, the candidate must meet the following requirements:

- Utah Air Force-connected youth
- Must have been in grades 7th-11th as of September 1, 2019
- Be available on:
  - August 29th
  - Other dates and times as needed (we will consider everyone's availability)
- Enjoy helping and teaching younger youth
- Be flexible with change as we will follow current and changing COVID-19 safety protocols

## Application Process

Each teen applying for 4-H Air Force Teens as Teachers will complete an application and submit it to Elizabeth Shaw. Application must be completed and submitted by August 21, 2020. Soon after each application is submitted, it will be reviewed and the youth will be notified of the decision.
