

AgVIP - Agricultural Voluntary Incentives Program

Purpose - Helps producers implement practices that can increase crop yields, improve soil health, and add value to operations while improving water quality. Open to dairies, feedlots, other CAFOs

- Operates in partnership with DWQ
- A one-time \$1,000 payment is issued to producers to develop a Comprehensive Nutrient Management Plan
- Once CNMP is implemented, \$12/acre payment will be issued for that year



Agricultural Water Optimization Grant

Purpose:

 Helps producers optimize water use while maintaining or improving agricultural production; improves water quantification via metering of diverted water; improves surface and ground water quality

- \$200 million made available to UDAF in 2023 session
- Requires 50/50 cost-share
- Projects must be "shovel ready"



Ag Stress Assistance Program

Purpose:

 Raise awareness of existing mental health resources for farmers, ranchers, and their family members. Provides \$2,000k vouchers per individual.

- Operates in partnership with USU AgWellness
- Made possible by a \$550k USDA NIFA FRSAN grant
- Also provides workshops, community outreach events, and training for 988 crisis line operators
- Currently, all voucher funds have been expended



Invasive Species Mitigation Program (Plant Industry Division)

Purpose:

Provides funding for projects to manage noxious weeds.

- Eligible organizations: Universities, Cooperative Weed
 Management Areas (CWMA's), County Weed Boards, Federal or State agencies, tribal or private landowners, Conservation
 Districts, nonprofits, political subdivisions
- Ranking criteria: Early detection/rapid response, rehabilitation, wildfire reduction, economic benefit, wildlife impact.



GIP - Grazing Improvement Program

Purpose - Helps producers improve the productivity and sustainability of rangelands, watersheds, and wildlife habitat through livestock grazing management practices.

- Includes restoration work, seeding, water projects
- Grants of up to \$100k per producer
- GIP Predatory Animal Control Grant (reimburses 50% of contracted predator control costs, \$150k available)
- GIP Small Producers Grant \$100k available, grants of up to \$10k
 for producers with 50 AMU or less



Resilient Food Systems Infrastructure Grant (RFSI)

Purpose:

 Improve middle of the food supply chain processing and strengthen regional food systems

- USDA AMS Cooperative Agreement issued to State
 Departments of Agriculture
- Technical Assistance Projects are also eligible



Salinity Offset Grant

Purpose:

Provides funds to salinity reduction projects

- In 2023 \$100k available for Lower Ashley Creek; \$700k
 available for Price & San Rafael Watersheds
- Future grant cycles tbd
- Projects will be solicited by UDAF in partnership with local Conservation Districts



Specialty Crop Block Grant (Marketing and Economic Development Division)

Purpose:

 Provides grants that enhance the competitiveness of Utah's specialty crop industry

- This is a USDA AMS grant that UDAF administers
- Projects must benefit more than one producer or organization
- Open to farmers, schools, trade associations, nonprofits, co-ops, farmers markets, etc.



Utah Pollinator Habitat Program (Conservation Division)

Purpose:

• Created by HB224 in 2021 to establish a 3 year pilot program to improve pollinator habitat in Utah.

- Provides up to 25% of the cost of planting pollinator-friendly native plants in Utah on private or public lands.
- This is not a cash award grant. Native plants and seed are distributed as ready-to-plant kits for awardees.
- Watersheds and pollinator corridors are priority areas.



Utah Food Security Processing Grant (UFSPG)

Purpose:

 Provides grants to increase in-state processing capacity for Utah-grown or raised food products.

- Reimburses applicants for a portion of expenses to expand existing processing facilities
- Expenses may include cold storage, contractor costs, processing and harvest equipment, livestock holding equipment, packaging equipment, etc.
- Currently under consideration by the legislature



Veterinary Education Loan Repayment Program

Purpose:

 Provides up to \$100k towards student loans for veterinarians who work for 5 years in underserved areas

- Made possible by HB 184 \$2.5m in funding available
- Vets may become eligible if they work in USDA designated veterinary shortage areas, Indian Country, for UDAF, for IRS exempt organizations, or for animal shelters
- New bill may make any vet practicing at least 30% livestock medicine eligible
