Utah's Iota Chapter held its first meeting on May 9, 1927 at the Eccles Hotel located in Logan, Utah. The first initiation ceremony honored six candidates and was held July, 1927.

Purpose

The purpose of Epsilon Sigma Phi is to maintain the standards and ideals, to uphold the morale, prestige, and respect of the Extension Service; to develop an effective working relationship and a spirit of fraternal fellowship among present and former Extension employees and to promote professionalism within the Extension Service.

Emblem

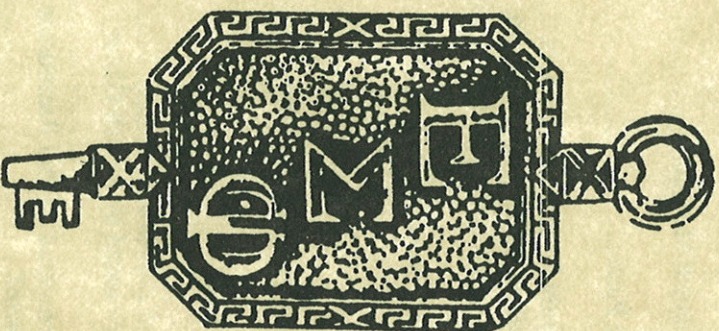
