There is funding out there

- Americans gave \$358.38 billion in 2014. This reflects a 7.1% increase from 2013.
- Corporate giving in 2014 increased to \$17.77 billion - a 13.7% increase from 2013.
- Foundation giving in 2014 increased to \$53.7 billion - an 8.2% increase from 2013.²
- In 2014, the largest source of charitable giving came from individuals at \$258.51 billion, or 72% of total giving; followed by foundations (\$53.97 billion/15%), bequests (\$28.13 billion/8%), and corporations (\$17.77 billion/5%).²

- Example: 4H Robotics \$5,000 or 4H Robotics between \$3,500 to \$6,000.
 - 1) A time frame or time line of when you need the funding.
- Example: Wellness Program – Grant funds needed by September 2016 or 4H Program Supplies needed over 6 month period starting by July 2016.

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
