

## Interpreter Resources

Extension employees who may need interpreter services, should consider the following resources:

- USU interpreters (USU students) are available for USU events if they are not scheduled to assist a USU student. (Students are first priority)
- Charge - \$35/hour for 1 hour.
- Additional interpreter will be needed if over 1 hour - \$70/hour
- If student interpreters are not available, the DRC can provide interpreters through an off-campus resource.
- Off campus resource charge – \$45-50/hour
- If the individual needing the service does not “sign”, the DRC can provide a student worker who will type *concepts of the meeting* on an iPad which is automatically sent to a “transcriber”
- iPad. This is a less costly service; \$15/hour.
- The DRC does request a 24 hour notice prior the event and asks for the event details through *email*.
- The DRC employs four Nationally Certified interpreters. Nationally Certified interpreters have tested at the highest level. They also provide novice interpreters who are under the tutelage of the Nationally Certified interpreters.
