

**Create Better Health (SNAP-Ed) Eligibility Waiver FY2021**

Note to Ambassador: This waiver must be used as directed below. The waiver is good for the undersigned group/location for one fiscal year after which it must be renewed. Upload and save a copy to your county's CBH Box folder and email or mail a copy to the state office.

**Locations that qualify and DO NOT require a waiver:** (State has one).

- Baby Your Baby.
- Head Start/Migrant Head Start.
- Schools with >50% eligible for free/reduced lunch.
- Neighborhoods and other locations within the boundaries of schools with >50% eligible for free/reduced lunch, and/or within census tracts or city boundaries where >50% eligible for SNAP-Ed.
- A qualifying grocery store (redeems >\$50,000 in SNAP benefits redemption monthly).
- Farmer's markets that have the Electronic Benefits Transfer (EBT) option.

**Locations that likely qualify, but MAY REQUIRE a waiver:**

- Deseret Industries.
- Senior Citizens centers (as eligible).
- Schools with 45-50% eligible for free/reduced lunch.

**Locations that DO NOT need a waiver:**

- SNAP participants
- DWS offices
- FDPPIR participants
- Food pantries/banks or DROPS services
- Soup kitchens
- Medicaid recipients
- TANF (welfare) recipients
- WIC
- Public (HUD) housing
