ENSURE YOUR EMPLOYEES CAN RESPOND AND SAVE LIVES

Utah State University (USU) Extension offers free Narcan training for service industry businesses such as restaurants, bars, hotels, and others. Please consider scheduling an employee training to ensure employees have the skills to respond to overdoses and save lives.



WHAT IS NARCAN?

Narcan is an easily administered nasal spray that reverses overdoses from opioids, including:

- Fentanyl.
- Heroin.
- Prescription opioids.

FENTANYL IS FATAL

- Just 2 mg is enough to kill most people.
- It has been found in counterfeit pressed pills, cocaine, heroin, and meth.

Recent research indicates an increased risk of service industry employees witnessing an opioid overdose at work or in their personal lives. This led USU to develop tailored trainings for employees to respond to opioid overdose and save lives.

Businesses that register for the training will receive an on-site emergency overdose prevention kit that includes Narcan, a CPR mask, gloves, and key items needed to respond to an overdose.

The training will last approximately 40 minutes and can be scheduled during shift changes, existing training times, or other convenient times for your employees to attend.
