The Stock

We offer bare root seedlings which come in a variety of species and sizes (see back for details) and are adaptable to a wide variety of environmental conditions in our area. The stock is all Grade A quality and is packaged to ensure the best possible pre-planting handling conditions.

Because we have no control over the handling of plants after distribution to customers, we cannot guarantee the survival of the stock after planting.

Stock supplies are limited, so orders are filled on a first-come, first-served basis and late orders may not be filled. If we are unable to fill your order completely, your order form and payment will be returned to you. We cannot fill partial orders. Please check the Conservation Tree & Shrub Program facebook page for updates on which trees are out of stock.

Trees and shrubs will be available for pick-up on May 3, 2024 at the SUU Valley Farm in Cedar City from 8 am to 5 pm, Triple C Arena in Panguitch, or FSA Office in Beaver. No staff is available to help with pick up in Panguitch or Beaver. All extra trees will be sold in Cedar City.

The Purpose

Plantings are generally intended to address conservation goals such as livestock protection, wildlife habitat, energy conservation and wind control. However, there are no restrictions on use. Windbreaks and shelter belts are excellent uses of these plants.

The Cost

In order to target conservation purposes such as windbreaks and shelter belts, **plants must be ordered in multiples of five of each individual species.** On the day of distribution to customers, (May 3, 2024) all extra trees will be sold in Cedar City. These trees will not need to be purchased in multiples of 5.

Also, payment in the form of check or cash must be received in order for us to secure the stock you request. A returned check fee of \$25 will be charged for all checks retuned unpaid.
