Happy New Year! Wait, what?! Happy New Year, I know what you are thinking. It's September. No, I haven't lost my mind. It's New Years. The 4-H New Year to be exact. Our year runs September 1- August 31. I am so excited for the new year and the adventures that are surely to await us.

This year in 4-H we have been working on some great camps and clubs. We cannot wait to get started. Here is what is planned so far:

Juab Livestock Club: Club meetings are on the second and fourth Tuesday of every month at the Extension office. We will be working on fitting, showmanship, proper nutrition, as well as working on Livestock Quiz bowl. This club is for youth age 8 & 3rd grade -18.

Juab Horse Riding Club: Club meetings are weekly on Thursday nights at 6 at the Juab County Fairgrounds. Helmets are required. We will be working on proper riding techniques, patterns, and showmanship. This club is for youth age 8 & 3rd grade-18.

Horse Study Nights: Club meetings are held on the first and third Tuesday of every month. We will be working on Horse quiz bowl, anatomy, horse judging. Etc. This club is for youth age 8-18.

Shooting Sports Club: Club meetings are on the 2nd and 4th Thursday of each month. We shoot Shotguns, .22 Rifles and Archery. Hunter's Safety is required prior to joining this club. This club is for youth ages 8 & 3rd grade -18.

Discover 4-H Club: Club meetings are on the first Monday of every month at the Extension office. In this club we will discover all 4-H has to offer like; Art, STEM, Quiz Bowls, AG, Horticulture, etc. This club is for youth 8-18 no grade requirements.

Discover Cloverbuds Club: Club meetings are on the first Monday of every month at the Extension office. In this club we will discover all 4-H has to offer like; Art, STEM, Quiz Bowls, AG, Horticulture, etc. This club is for Cloverbuds only. 5-7 years old.

Juab Teen Council: Club Meetings are the second Wednesday of every month. Teens work, plan, and play together to strengthen their own personal leadership, communication, and team work skills while mentoring and teaching younger youth. This club is for teen youth in grades 7-12th.

Annual 4- H Family Night out. This year will be held October 9th. At the Juab County Fairgrounds. Everyone is welcome, whether you have been in 4-H your whole life or would just like to learn more about what we do. Please join us! Dinner will be served as well as games for the whole family. Rounding off the night with firepits and tons of smores. Can't wait to see you there!

Afterschool 4-H Programs: Programing is currently being offered at Red Cliffs, Nebo View, Eureka, West Desert, and Mona Elementary as well as Juab Junior High. Programs will vary to each location but may include STEM, Leathercraft, Sewing, Fitness, and Homework Help. This is for kids grades K-8.

We are also working on some Camps. We will be offering Sewing, Cooking, Beadworking, Gift Making, Leathercraft, Babysitting, and Resume building. Watch our social media and emails for updates and scheduling for these. These camps are for youth ages 8-18.
