For many in Juab County, gardening is more than just a hobby—it's a way to connect with nature, grow fresh produce, and enjoy a little dirt therapy. But for those without the space at home, the Juab Community Garden offers the perfect solution.

Tucked away on the north end of the Juab County Fairgrounds, this garden provides residents with the opportunity to cultivate their own plants in a shared, community-oriented space. With 20 plots available, each measuring 4 feet by 10 feet, there's room for gardeners of all experience levels to dig in.

One of the many perks of the community garden is convenience. All the necessary gardening tools are provided and stored in an on-site shed, making it easy for participants to plant, water, and maintain their plots without the hassle of hauling supplies back and forth.

A small fee helps cover maintenance costs and water usage, but here's the best part—gardeners who clean up their plots at the end of the season and remove all debris will receive a full refund.

Plots are assigned on a first-come, first-served basis, and with gardening season just around the corner, now is the time to secure your spot.
