Entry Information for Morgan County Exhibitors:

1. All Morgan County exhibitors (even if you are not participating in the show) need to register on @ <http://www.fairentry.com/Fair/SignIn/21891> no later than Friday, May 30, 2025 by 6:00 pm. You will need to upload your Bill of Sale at this time.
2. All Morgan County exhibitors must have shown EACH participating animal at the Morgan County Jr. Livestock Spring Show, any other state sanctioned Jr. Livestock show, or a Jackpot Show approved by their Species Supervisors, to be eligible to show at the Morgan County Fair.
3. Lambs will weigh in on a separate day from their show. Beef and Hogs will weigh in on the day of their show.
4. Classes will be set by weight after weighing in.
5. Morgan Co. Jr. Livestock Show is not a terminal show. Ownership requirements may be different than other state sponsored shows.
6. Admission to the show will be free.

Entry Information for Out of County Exhibitors:

1. The Morgan County Spring Show is a Utah State Sanctioned Show. Only Utah residents will be allowed to enter and show.
2. All other Exhibitors will need to register on FairEntry @ <http://www.fairentry.com/Fair/SignIn/21891> no later than Friday, May 23, 2025, by 6:00 pm. When you come to the part where you are required to upload documents to continue, just upload a blank document in both areas. This is only required for Morgan County exhibitors.



3. Out of County Hogs, Beef and Lambs will weigh in on the day of their show.
4. Classes will be set by weight after weighing in.
5. Morgan Co. Jr. Livestock Show is not a terminal show. Ownership requirements may be different than other state sponsored shows.
6. Admission to the show will be free.

GENERAL RULES

Exhibitor Requirements

The Morgan County Spring Show is a Utah State Sanctioned Show. Only Utah residents will be allowed to enter and show.

1. 8 years of age as of September 1 of the current 4-H year. Exhibitors can only show through the same season as their high school graduation, but not past their 19th birthday.
2. Group Affiliation -- An exhibitor may enter a given show only as a 4-H or FFA member, but not both. Exhibitors must declare one or the other at time of entry. This will be verified with your County Extension Office or FFA Advisor.
3. Dress Code: 4-H - A long or short-sleeved shirt, which fastens down the front with a collar, is mandatory. Shirts must be solid white in color and need not be Western style. Black or blue pants are to be worn. There is to be a 4-H emblem or patch on all 4-H member shirts.
 - a. FFA - Either a white shirt, tie and FFA jacket, or a white shirt with the FFA emblem and tie (t-shirts are not allowed.)
 - b. The following will not be allowed: T-shirts, tank tops, tube tops, sleeveless shirts, ripped pants, vests and open-toed shoes. Exhibitors who fail to abide by dress standards will forfeit prize money.



4. Each exhibitor showing an animal is encouraged to participate in the showmanship contest and must use his/her OWN animal.
5. Appropriate behavior of both youth exhibitors and parents is expected! There will be no tolerance for foul language or inappropriate treatment of animals, judges or show officials. Any infraction of this rule may result in a dismissal from the premises or banishment from future shows.

Animal Requirements

1. Show Eligibility - Animals are eligible for any show for which they meet ownership and show requirements.
2. Unaltered/Intact male animals are not allowed to show. If there is enough interest, we can add breeding classes to this show the following year.
3. All animals will be subject to a health inspection at weigh-in. Vaccination of animals prior to show is recommended. Ewe lambs are required to have a scrapie tag. Any animal found unhealthy will be removed from the grounds. All livestock FDA rules on the use of drugs will be the responsibility of the exhibitor. Anyone using drugs on livestock will have the animal withdrawn from the show. Any animal force fed will not be allowed to show. Unruly animals will be sifted at the discretion of the species supervisors.
4. Fitting on show grounds -- Parents, guardians, siblings, club leaders, extension/4-H agents and FFA advisors may assist and are encouraged to assist the younger exhibitors. However, each exhibitor must be working with the project animal and be in attendance with that animal during the entire fitting process.

Show Requirements

1. Adults cannot show animals for youth.
2. Judging of beef, sheep and swine will be by the Danish System. The judges will be instructed to award premiums according to the merit of the exhibit regardless of competition.



3. Showmanship will be divided and posted into the following classes.
 - a. Junior Showman (3-5 grade)
 - b. Intermediate Showman (6-8 grade)
 - c. Senior Showman (9-12 grade)
4. There must be two or more entries in each class before a Grand Champion can be selected.
5. Buckles, Certificates and Banners will be given to Champion and Reserve in each department and all age groups.
6. All premium money will be awarded proportionately to exhibitors according to points won.
7. Premium money will be sent to exhibitors residing outside the county. Please ensure that your correct address are provided during registration.

General Information:

1. The show officers will use every precaution to protect livestock and participants while at the show. HOWEVER, THEY ASSUME NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR INJURY OR LOSS FROM ANY CAUSE.
2. There is no longer a water system in the hog barn. You will need to bring your own system for watering your hogs.
3. Clean up your pens and area when you are done. Please leave it better than you found it.
