

Brown Marmorated Stink Bug
Help prevent these invasive insects from hitching a ride to new locations.

The brown marmorated stink bug was accidentally introduced from Asia, and causes extensive damage to many types of ornamental plants, shrubs, trees, and fruit and vegetable crops. This pest has a **mottled brown and shield-shaped body, distinct banding on antennae, legs and edge of back, and smooth and rounded shoulders** (as opposed to toothed and pointed shoulders of other stink bugs). It is about **5/8 inch long.**
