


#### Monolog



#### MEDIA ADVISORY

#### WHAT:

This weekend, the district will be using approximately 100 goats to help control weeds and overgrowth on the hill behind Washington Elementary School. The goats will eat nearly all the vegetation on the hillside, leaves on trees up to six feet high, and saplings up to about one inch in diameter. A herder will be on site during the entire weekend to supervise the process.

#### WHEN

The goats will arrive Friday afternoon and be removed Monday morning. District representatives will be at the school available for comment on Saturday morning at 10 a.m.

#### WHERE:

Washington Elementary School 420 North 200 West Salt Lake City

#### MORE INFORMATION:

The district has struggled with landscaping issues on the east side of Washington since the school was rebuilt. Most areas on this hillside are too steep for turf grass. Areas with more moderate slopes were planted with wildflowers but are now overrun with weeds. The steeper areas are a mixture of mature existing trees and trash trees.

In the past, the only way to manage this landscaping has been to dedicate nearly all the grounds staff for a week to manually weed and trim the undergrowth. The district has also investigated alternative landscaping solutions such as terracing the hillside with paths and retaining walls. Both options are very expensive and time consuming. For approximately \$2,000, the goats can accomplish exactly what is needed in less time than our grounds maintenance staff and without the use of chemical herbicides.

After the hillside has been cleared by the goats, the district plans to keep the mature trees and remove any remaining trash trees. Then, grounds crews will plant native plants that will thrive on the hillside.



#### Pesticide Facts

Health effects of 48 commonly used pesticides in schools and child care facilities and schools:

- 22 are probable carcinogens,
- 26 cause reproductive effects,
- 31 damage the nervous system,
- 31 injure the liver or kidney,
- 41 are sensitizers or irritants,
- 16 can cause birth defects.
