Directions to the ranch:

1. Take I-80 west
2. Exit 113 to 5600 W
3. Turn right at the stop light onto 5600 W (heading north)
4. At the next light, turn left onto Amelia Earhart Drive
5. Follow Amelia Earhart Dr. to John Glenn Road (heading west)
6. Turn right onto John Glenn Road (heading north)
7. When the road ends, turn left onto a dirt road (heading west)
8. Drive through the large white gate
9. Continue straight at first intersection
10. When the road is blocked by gates, take the right-most gate (north of road)
11. Follow that road until you can turn north
12. Turn north
13. Follow road until you reach the kidding corral (you will be going west at this point)
14. Park in the hay yard, entrance is next to white shipping container
