

## ***4-H Wasatch Front Horse Contests***

Davis, Salt Lake, Utah, and Weber Counties

May 21, 2016 @ 9:00 a.m.

Weber County has invited the Wasatch Front counties of Utah, Salt Lake, Davis, and Weber Counties to the first annual 4-H Wasatch Front Horse Contests. The purpose of this competition is to provide an avenue for youth along the Wasatch Front interested in the horse project area to be involved in more horse related events. In addition, this event is intended to prepare youth for state and national competitions. The ultimate goal is to increase the number of youth involved in 4-H horse projects along the Wasatch Front and increase the number of youth attending State 4-H Contests in Logan.

The contests will consist of 4-H Horse Judging and 4-H Horse Bowl competitions. Both contests will be available for all youth in the junior (3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup>), intermediate (6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>), and senior (9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>) age groups.

### **4-H Horse Judging**

The rules are as follows:

- Participants will evaluate horses.
- Individual scores will be added to comprise a team score.

Entries: Participants may enter as individuals or teams of three to four members. If entering as a team all team members must be of the same age group (junior, intermediate, or senior) and be from the same county.

Awards will be given to winners of the top individuals and team in each age group.

### **4-H Horse Bowl**

The rules for the horse bowl will be the same rules used at 4-H State Contests in Logan. This is a team only event and team members must be of the same age group (junior, intermediate, or senior) and county. Rules for Horse Bowl can be found >[HERE](#)<

Awards will be given to the top individuals and team in each age group.

### **Schedule of Events - Golden Spike Arena (Weber County Fairgrounds)**

9:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. / Horse Judging Competition

All age groups will judge horse classes at the same time but in a rotation order patterned after 4-H State Contests. Winners of the horse judging competition will be awarded following the horse bowl competition.

12:00 p.m. - 1:30 p.m. (lunch on your own)

There are many different restaurant, grocery store, and convenience store choices close by in Ogden.

1:30 pm- until finished / Horse Bowl Competition

Winners of the horse bowl competition will be known immediately after the event and awards will be given to the top team in each age group.
