4-Hers may enter 4-H classes, All Breed Classes, and/or APHA classes (must have a registered paint for APHA classes). Registration for 4-H classes will be done through 4-H Online. #### Event Rules

- 4-Hers will follow all basic exhibitors rules in the Utah 4-H Rulebook, including but not limited to:
  - Must follow the 4-H Code of Conduct & all behavior rules
  - Must wear a helmet while mounted in the arena
  - Must wear a 4-H Patch on the left sleeve
  - Must follow the Utah 4-H Equine Drug Policy
  - Exhibitor must provide the horse he/she uses. Horse may be leased or borrowed, provided the member has major responsibility for the care and maintenance
- All classes, class procedures and scoring will follow APHA Rules. APHA rulebook can be found here: <http://apha.com/forms/rule-books/>
- All tack and equipment requirements will follow APHA Rules.
- 4-Hers may enter more than one horse, but points will follow horse + rider combinations. Each additional horse will be an extra \$20.00 fee.
- All exhibitors are prohibited from approaching judges, even to ask questions
- Event will follow UPHC Biosecurity policy, which is that current Health Certificate, Coggins and Brand Inspections are recommended

**4-H Highpoint Awards:** Highpoint awards will be given for combined score of all 4-H classes offered. Points follow horse + rider combination.

**Ages:** 4-H classes will be all-age, unless registration is big enough to split by age level – so spread the word!

**Ranch Riding Clinic:** This event includes a clinic put on by Back 2 Basics show judge LeAnn Williams. 4-H registration fee includes an audit of this clinic. There are 10 spots available for riders at an additional \$20.00 cost. Riders will be selected first come, first served. The clinic will be March 22<sup>nd</sup> at 1:00 PM. The clinic is only offered as part of the horse show, meaning that you must register for the show in order to attend.
