Specie Specialist -

Goats - Colton & Kelsey Coates - Thought things went good, liked the weight change.

Lambs - Brent & Vivian Sorensen - Doesn't think that lambs/anything other than steers should be allowed at May weigh ins.

Tausha Anderson - Thinks that exhibitors should be able to show both of their animals even if they are both in the same weight class.

Laura B said we discussed and changed the rule last year. There were a lot of discussions by many people.

Tausha Anderson motioned that the rule gets changed and that the exhibitor/parent can choose to bump an extra animal to the next class in market if they are in the same class/ Brent Sorenson second it. 5 in favor 16 opposed - the rule will stay the same.

Brent didn't like that any animals could come to the beef weigh-ins. It was discussed that the committee will communicate with the species specialists about who comes to the May weigh-in.

Swine - Markell said everything was good with swine.

Beef - Tausha and Wade said that everything needs to be weighed in with the specie specialist.

\*Tausha Anderson motioned that all animals crossing the scale need to have a committee member and a specie specialists to weigh in. Kelsey Coates second, all in favor.

Laura Barker asked to add that we add that you can sale a beef and another animal.

\*Kelsey Coats Motion that you can sell a beef/or a goat and one other specie, a total of two animals. Ashley Denton second. All in favor

Dairy - Brittany - Thought show went well. Would like a better check in process, if a tattoo is there they need to include it in fair entry. Also need some record of who the grand is that is no longer eligible.

Tausha - said that dairy should have to follow the same rules, including no replacement of animals if one should die.

Laura requested that all dairy rules be separate in the rule book.

\*Tausha motioned that no animals can be tagged in after initial weigh-ins, market and dairy. Ashley Denton second, all in favor.

### Rule Changes

Wade brought up the boost rule with all boost being donated to SCJLA. Laura B proposed that we change the boost.

Motion will be made that boost will be changed ...

\*Rule 50 All boost money is donated through Sanpete County. In order to receive the boost money the exhibitor's animal must make weight at final weigh-ins. Only market animals will be eligible for boost.

\*Rule 51 Boost money donations will open Thursday of the show and stay open for 30 days.

Meagan Dyreng motioned, Markell Barclay second, all in favor

Wade brought up that our show is a closed county show. So only kids in this county can exhibit at our show.

Exhibitor Qualifications -

\*All youth must be enrolled and have fees paid in either Sanpete County 4-H or FFA by May 1st of the current year and have a parent or legal guardian with a Sanpete County permanent address before they will be allowed to tag in animals. All FFA members need to declare their participation to their advisors by May 1st.

Laura Lister motioned, Kelsey Coates second, all in favor

\*Wade brought up that the rule book and the bylaws for the grievance committee need to read the same.

Meagan Dyreng motion, Markell Barclay second, all in favor

We need to add the fair board, county commissioner, and county attorney to the grievance committee. This needs to be changed in the bylaws, which need to be changed in January.

\*Laura B brought up changing the reweigh from a 5 lb overall.

Brittany Hooser motioned that in order for an animal to be eligible for reweigh it needs to be within 2% of the minimum weight. Ashley Denton second, all in favor.
