Awards Banquet -

Everyone liked doing the buckles at the fair instead of the awards banquet. Keep buckles awarded at the show. Dinner went well.

Finances -

4H -

The clinics have been awesome, everyone really likes them. Everyone needs to be signed up/registered so they can get the info on the clinics.

Rule Changes -

- Change minimum final weight for swine to 220 lbs.
- Sale declarations must be turned in by 5 PM on the day of the Market Show. If not turned in you cannot sell an animal.
- Each exhibitor is required to turn in a W-9 in order to sell an animal. W-9's must be turned in by the initial weigh in.
- Add questions from rule book to the test
- Animals must be signed out before they can be removed/taken home from the fair.

- Change the tag in fee to \$15, \$5 will be returned when your animal is singed out. Extra animals that you tag in, but do not show will get the \$5 back when you sign out your animals at the fair. If you are selling your animal you can sign out your animal when you turn in your sale declaration.
- In the showmanship classes you must show the same animal in the final drive that you showed in your class.
- Rule #10 - remove family
- If an animal is unable to be shown after the final weigh ins, but prior to the show, they may talk with the committee before the show and show a different animal that is already tagged in at the fair.
- Tags need to be clean/readable for final weigh ins
- All boost money is donated to the S.C.J.L.A.. In order to receive the boost money that the exhibitor collected the animal must go through the sale.
- Boost money must be turned in by 2 PM on Saturday.
- Extra animals that did not go through the sale can be sold through S.C.J.L.A. for the exhibitor, and be sent to the processor. The S.C.J.L.A. will collect the 5% commission on the sale of the extra animal.
