



# American Flag

## MATERIALS NEEDED

- 5 red fabric strips
- 1 block of blue fabric
- Background fabric
- 5/16" x 12" wooden dowel rod
- 3 wooden stars
- 9 red, white, and blue beads
- Jute twine

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

### Fabric #1

- (3 of the red fabric)  $\frac{5}{8}$ " x  $3 \frac{3}{4}$ "
- (2 of the red fabric)  $\frac{5}{8}$ " x  $7 \frac{7}{8}$ "

### Fabric #2

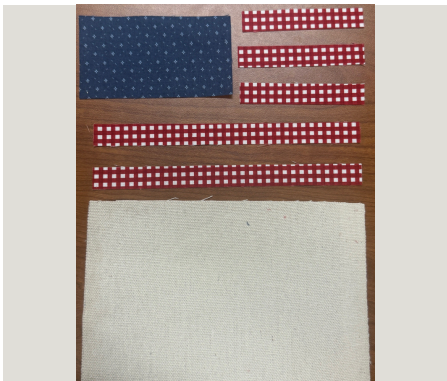
- (1 of the blue fabric)  $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4 \frac{1}{2}$ "

### Background fabric

- 1 of the white canvas (paint drop cloth) 5" x 8"



## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS



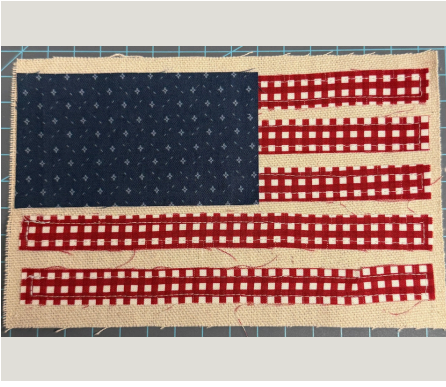
1. Lay out all of the fabric pieces.



2. Place the red fabric pieces on the white canvas as shown above. Try to space them evenly. If you would like the strips to be shorter, you can place them farther left, that side won't be visible from the front.



3. Once you like where the red fabric pieces are placed, sew them on to the white canvas.



4. Next, position the blue fabric how you would like. Again, if you want it shorter, you can place it more to the left.



5. Sew around the edge of the blue fabric.



6. Fold in the left side of the canvas  $\frac{5}{8}$ " or  $\frac{3}{4}$ ". Pin in place, then sew. It is easier, sew on the backside to ensure all fabric is included.



7. Insert the dowel and embellish with jute, beads, and stars however you would like!
