Wood U Could U	Within ¼ mile from Spring Creek TH on north side of Preserve	Devious/ Micro	N40/43.730' W111/32/338'	Easy/Flat Terrain	No Geocache Swag in this cache
Sagebrush	Within 1 mile of Spring Creek TH on north side of Preserve	Micro	N40/43.660' W111/31.815'	Medium/Rolling	Bring pen or pencil; No Geocache Swag in this cache
Good Spot	Within 1 mile of EcoCenter	Micro	N40/42.954' W111/32.665'	Easy/Flat Terrain	Bring very small swag to trade/pencil included in this cache
Whose Back?	Within 2 miles	Regular	N40/43.715' W111/32.245'	Medium degree of difficulty for adults/may be difficult for children due to distance and relative steepness of terrain	Bring swag to trade
So Knot Board	Within ½ mile of Spring Creek TH	Small	N40/43.715' W111/32.245'	Easy/Flat Terrain	Bring swag to trade

Geocaching Vocabulary

Type of Caches

- **Nano:** The tiniest of the geocache containers, typically with a magnetic base (**coming soon!**)
- **Micro:** Small container usually less than 100 ML; typically contains only a small logbook and log sheet, with or without a small pencil.
- **Small:** A sandwich-sized plastic container; holds a logbook, pencil, and swag.
- **Regular:** A plastic container or ammo container. About the size of a shoebox. Contains logbook, pencil, and swag.
- **Devious:** An unusual container.

Swag

- Swag turns the adventure of geocaching into a treasure hunt! You never know what the Swag staff or visitors to the cache may leave for you to enjoy. 😊
- **Remember:** If you take something, leave something of *equal or greater value in return*.
- Ideas for swag:
 - Store-bought items such as toys, jewelry, small books, gift cards, charms, small notebooks, deck of cards, hair clips, refrigerator magnets, stickers, or postcards.
 - Handmade items such as duct tape wallets, friendship bracelets, keychains, bookmarks, refrigerator magnets, or jewelry.
 - Polished or painted stones
 - Coins
- What not to bring:
 - Candy, gum, or food
 - Scented items
 - Explosives, ammunition, knives, drugs, or alcohol
