4. Application must be accompanied by your high school transcript.
5. Application must be accompanied by a one page cover letter.
6. Application must be accompanied by two letters of recommendation. (No family or 4-H/FFA Advisor)
7. Application must be accompanied by a 1 minute video of you/ you and your animals. Please introduce yourself and answer some of the following questions.

(If you would like to video yourself that is great or reach out to Ashlee Warner and schedule a time to record. Note: all videos are subject to be used for TCJLS social media pages.)

- How many years have you been involved in livestock projects, and what species have you raised and exhibited?
- Describe a challenge you faced with an animal project and how you overcame it.
- What life skills have you gained through raising livestock?
- What is the most valuable lesson livestock projects have taught you?
- How has participating in the livestock program shaped who you are today?
- Tell us about a setback you experienced and what you learned from it.
- What personal qualities have helped you succeed in your livestock projects?
- Who has had the greatest influence on your livestock journey?
