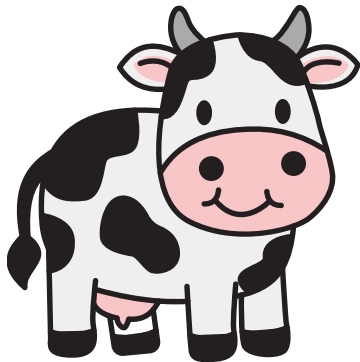
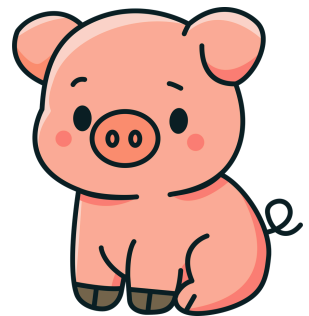

SMALL ANIMAL CONTEST GUIDELINES

- CLEAN Animals are to be checked in from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. on Friday July 31, 2026 at the Pavilion building at The Peak.
- Owner agrees to be responsible for food and water for animal twice a day. Water is available onsite.
- Owner agrees to spend 2 hours managing the contest area *per animal entry* during Heritage Days (sign up for shifts at registration).
- Animals must be picked up on Sat. Aug. 1 at 7 p.m.

Examples of small animals are chickens, pigeons, guinea pigs & rabbits. Entry must be able to fit comfortably in a 18x18x24 inch pen. Contest is open to all residents of Tooele County. For more information contact: Linden Greenhalgh 435-840-2882

Table Setting Contest at Heritage Days

Here are the rules:

1. Register on 4h.zsuite.org for this free contest
2. Design a table setting for a meal or event of your choice. (example: a 4th of July BBQ)
3. Plan the menu. Print up a card with your name and your menu on it. Include everything you will serve: e.g. main dish, side dishes, bread, dessert and beverage. Good nutrition counts.
4. Think of a color scheme/theme, place cards, centerpiece, table covering, dishes and the utensils needed.
5. Bring your menu card, a 1-place setting with centerpiece and table covering to Deseret Peak on Monday, July 28th anytime between 1-7 pm, set it up for judging and display. Entry must be set up by the participant.
6. Judging points are: correct table setting, originality, color scheme, centerpiece, appropriate for menu and attractiveness. (We encourage creativity but the judge must feel comfortable eating at your table as it is set.) Bring it to The Peak on **Monday July 27**, anytime between **1-7 pm**. Set up a 1 place table setting (24"x24") and then leave it set up to be judged and displayed for everyone to see at the fair!

Happy 250 America Fabric Challenge

Open to all county residents, all ages

Step 1: Pick up a Fabric Challenge Kit from the 4-H Office

Step 2: Use at least $\frac{1}{2}$ the fabric provided, an all three buttons and ribbon. You can sew, glue, staple, cut...it's up to you!

Step 3: Bring it to Heritage Days exhibit drop-off July 27th between 1-7pm

To Register Exhibits into EzFair

1. Follow the link provided by your county.
2. Click the blue REGISTER AN EXHIBIT button
3. Click the green ENTER YOUR ZSUITE CREDENTIALS button
4. Log in to ZSuite



Register Your Exhibitor

1. Select the youth you are entering exhibits for (if their name doesn't appear, type in their name and it will populate if they are assigned to you as a leader)
2. Select 4-H in Age Division field
3. Ensure information from ZSuite is correct.
4. Click Blue NEXT button.



Enter Exhibits

1. Select 4-H Indoor Exhibits for exhibit type
2. Select the Department for the exhibit you are entering
3. Select the Division
4. Select the Class
5. Fill out the questions for this exhibit - make sure to include a detail description.
6. If you have another exhibit for this Exhibitor, select the Green Add another exhibit button and repeat.



Completing Registration

1. Once all exhibits are entered for this exhibitor, click the blue DONE button.
2. Sign waivers
3. Repeat process for additional exhibitors.

We will print your tags and have them ready for you at check-in July 27th from 1-7pm

Registration ends July 22nd.
No late submissions will be accepted.
