We love having our 4-H community grow! Recently the workshops we offer in our office have been filling quickly, so we are trying to adjust to make sure all kids have a chance to learn and grow with us.

- **Waitlist option-** When you register for a workshop, you will choose whether to register as "Regular 4-H/Cloverbud" or "Waitlist". If "Regular" registrations fill, you can still register on the "waitlist" so we know how many youth would like to attend.
- **"First-time participant"**- this will be a third registration option. We will reserve 2 spots per workshop for those who haven't attended before. If those spots haven't filled when registration closes, Kortni will reach out to those on the waitlist to fill spots.
- **Fair Exhibit Deadline-** ALL 4-H Exhibits must be registered online by July 23rd. Registration is done online at ez-fair.com and needs to be brought to the 4-H area of fair on July 28th. Tooele County Jr. Livestock Show

Things to know:



- 4-H youth must be 8 years old as of Sept. 1, 2024 and in the 3rd grade for this 2024-25 school year.
- Youth may show 1 animal in up to 4 species (beef, goat, sheep, swine) or 2 animals of the same species.
- Beef projects must be tagged by now.
- All goats, lambs and swine must be tagged* by **May 31**. Tagging days and locations will be announced soon.
- Entries are online through faireentry.com starting **May 1st**. Sale book & "show check-list" available online at tooele4h.org.
- Pen set-up is at Deseret peak Monday, July 28th at 8am. All youth exhibitors are encouraged to help.
- **The weigh-in for market livestock is Wednesday July 30th from 4-6pm.**
- The Tooele County Jr. Livestock Show will be **July 30- Aug 2, 2025** at Deseret Peak. Questions, call the 4-H office (435)277-2405.
