




Blanket Tying Event




LEARN LIVESTOCK EDUCATION SERIES




Learn about Dogs, from Their Nose to Their Toes

The Utah County 4-H Dog is still accepting members! At weekly meetings, club members will learn all about the proper care and handling of dogs from their nose to toes. They also learn how to compete in 4-H showmanship, American Kennel Club obedience and rally.

To compete, youth must be ages 8 to 18 but we allow youth 5 and up to participate. All ages and breeds or mixed breed dogs are allowed to be part of the project. Youth may compete with more than one dog and siblings may share one dog and compete in separate events.
