LIVESTOCK TAGGING SEASON IS HERE



Attention all livestock exhibitors (and parents)! This month, tagging will begin again! Tagging your animal is a crucial step in your livestock project, as it establishes ownership and ensures your animal is eligible for entry in junior livestock shows.

Preparation

Here's the steps you'll need to take before bringing your animal to a tagging event:

1. Enroll in 4-H: go to 4h.zsuite.org to update your enrollment or create a new account. A \$10 enrollment fee will apply.
2. The fee is \$2 per tag and must be paid online through 4h.zsuite.org.

Tagging Deadlines

Cattle must be tagged 100 days before the desired show. Hogs, sheep, and goats must be tagged 60 days before the desired show. Please note that tagging an animal does not register youth for the show, but is required for registration.
