THE UTAH COUNTY MASTER GARDENER PROGRAM

WHAT IS A MASTER GARDENER?

Master Gardeners are trained volunteers willing to share their time and expertise to help their community garden more successfully. The program is an educational outreach of Utah State University Extension. Each spring classes are taught at Thanksgiving Point and Provo. Gardeners meet for instruction weekly and attend monthly labs.

VOLUNTEER TRAINING

Each Master Gardener also completes 40 hours of volunteer service by doing things like:

- garden talks
- gardening demonstrations
- judge at county fairs
- volunteer at Farm Field Days
- diagnose plant problems and answer gardening questions in the Diagnostic Lab at the USU Extension office in Provo
- volunteer for the Hidden Garden Tour
